

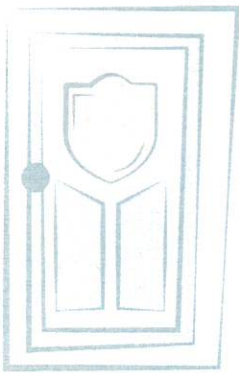

Fall In Shop Programs

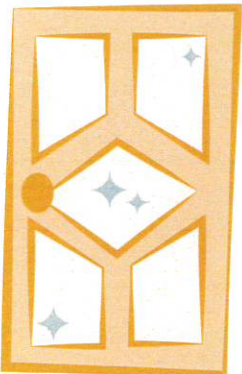

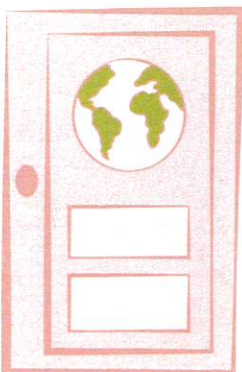
Elementary Strength:

This program was created for young boys to emphasize teamwork and collaboration, help them understand and manage their feelings, and support the discovery of their individual strengths and interests through means of group discussion, journaling, games, and hand on crafts. This program is open to boys in grades K - 4. ***This Fall, Elementary Strength will take place on Mondays from 3:45 pm to 5:45 pm at the Open Door Project. Elementary Shine:

In Elementary Shine, young girls begin the process of learning about their intrinsic self-worth and the worth of other girls in a safe and welcoming environment through use of journaling questions, guided group discussions, and creative projects that encourage unique personality, interests, and talents to shine, while also learning how to encourage and support other girls to shine bright too. This program is open to girls in grades K -4. ***This Fall, Elementary Shine will take place on Tuesdays from 3:45 pm to 5:45 pm. Community Connected

This program's goal is to create community and connection among the children of our community through reading and discussion circles, crafts, games, and community service efforts. Students build resilience and connections with peers of different ages, while also learning the value of taking care of themselves, each other, their community, and the Earth!
