How to learn a song by yourself

- 1. Identify the notes. Write them in if you have to.
- Make sure you know how to play each note. Use the resources on the page for fingerings or slide positions. Brass and flute players need to make sure lips are in the correct position for high and/or low notes.
- 3. **Identify which notes are long and which are short.** Long notes are not colored in, short are colored in. 8th notes are 2 notes connected with a bar-think "ap-ple."
- 4. Play the song SLOWLY.
- 5. **If the song is long, chunk it into shorter sections.** Slowly repeat the section over and over until you can play it correctly without mistakes. Then, repeat the process with another section until you finish the entire song.
- 6. If you keep making mistakes, chunk the song into even shorter sections or play even more slowly before going faster.
